

12 DAYS / 9 NIGHTS HIGHLIGHTS OF SPAIN & PORTUGAL

BARCELONA / ZARAGOZA / MADRID / BADAJOZ / LISBON / SEVILLE / CORDOBA / GRANADA / ALICANTE

DAY 01 : KUALA LUMPUR / DOHA

• Assemble at KLIA International Airport for your pleasant flight to Barcelona via Doha .

Tour code: BAR12QR

DAY 02 : DOHA / BARCELONA (CHINESE LUNCH / WESTERN DINNER)

- Welcome to Barcelona , the capital and the most populous city of the Autonomous Community of Catalonia and the second largest city in Spain.
- An early arrival in Barcelona this morning orientation tour to see the **Gothic Quarter** where, among the narrow streets ,visit the **ancient Cathedral**.
- See the **Columbus Monument**, a 60m high monument stand at the center of the Square of the Gate of Peace, **Columbus Square** , **Catalunia Square** , **Park Guell** and **Plaza Espana**.
- Drive out to the **Example District** to see some of Gaudi's extraordinary architecture, including entrance to the unfinished **Sagrada Familia Cathedral**, which has been under construction since 1882 and still on going another 30 to 80 years before it will be finished. (It is depending on funding and resources).
- Drive pass to view the famous **Castillo De Montjuic** , overlooking the city and Olympic Stadium .
- Entrance to the **Spanish Village** , a real village with streets and squares, without wheeled traffic and in the natural.
- In the afternoon, stroll along **Las Ramblas** , the most famous street which consist of 5 boulevards joined to a long beautiful pedestrian street where can shop for variety of branded goods .

DAY 03 : BARCELONA(309KM) / ZARAGOZA(315KM) / MADRID (BREAKFAST / CHINESE DINNER)

- This morning, our journey take us to Zaragoza , the capital of Aragon in Spain.
- Orientation feature the **Basilica de Nuestra Senora del Pilar** which is one of the most visited place of pilgrimage, consecrated to the " Holy Virgin of Pilar.
- Next to see **De La Seo Cathedral** and **The Aljaferia** ,is splendid king's palace of 11th century is one of very few remaining Moorish building of the dynasty "Taifas".
- Continue to Madrid, the Spanish capital for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 04 : MADRID (BREAKFAST/PAELLA DINNER)

- This morning sightseeing tours visit to **The Royal Palace** which was built during the 18th and 19th centuries, is official residence for the Spanish Royal family, although they use it for state occasions. It's sheer scale and vast courtyard is impressive, and you can enter the palace to get a look at the lavish halls, banqueting rooms, throne room, residential areas and the Royal Armoury and Royal Pharmacy.
- Orientation tours takes you along the **Gran Via & Paseo de la Castellana**. See the Cervantes Monument in the **Plaza Espana**, the **Puerta del Sol**, Madrid most famous fountain in the Plaza de la Cibeles.
- Visit to the **Prado Museum** to admire the paintings of Velázquez, Goya & many others

DAY05 : MADRID (71KM) / TOLEDO (363KM) / BADAJOZ (BREAKFAST/WESTERN DINNER)

- After breakfast, drive to Toledo, the former capital of Spanish Empire.
- Visit the Cathedral, Entrance to the **Santo Tome Church**, and see the ancient **Synagogue**, **Bisagra's Gate**, **Alcantara Bridge** and the **Alcazar**.
- Continue on a scenic drive to Badajoz , is the capital of the Spanish province of Badajoz in the autonomous community of Extremadura, situated close to the Portuguese border.

DAY 06 : BADAJOZ (227KM) / LISBON (BREAKFAST / WESTERN LUNCH / PORTUGUESE SEAFOOD DINNER)

- This morning travel to Lisbon, the capital city of Portugal.
- Sightseeing to see the **Monument to the Discoveries** which was inaugurated in 1960 during the celebration of the 500 year anniversary of the death of Henry the Navigator .
- Then see the beautiful suspension bridge across the Tagus river and admire views of the **Belem Tower** which was built in the early 16th century to commemorate Vasco da Gama's expedition.
- Later visit the **Jeronimos Monastery** with its superbly ornate cloister.
- Walk around the quaint **Alfama District**, an old quarters with cobbled stone lane and the narrowest street in Lisbon.
- Tonight , enjoy Portuguese seafood dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 07 : LISBON (171KM) / SEVILLE (BREAKFAST / SPANISH FLAMENCO DINNER SHOW)

- Orientation tour includes the **immense Cathedral**, **burial place of Christopher Columbus**, & the **slender Giralda Tower**. Stroll along the narrow old **Santa Cruz Quarter** with its flower-decked wrought iron balconies, a once thriving Jewish quarter & see the **Royal Alcazar**.
- Tonight enjoy dinner with entertainment featuring a fiery **Flamenco show**.

DAY 08 : SEVILLE (142KM) / CORDOBA (222KM) / GRANADA (BREAKFAST / CHINESE LUNCH / WESTERN DINNER)

- This morning travel to Roman-founded Cordoba, a capital of Muslim Spain. Visit the **Mezquita**, grandest and most beautiful mosque ever constructed by the Moors in Spain. It stand right in the centre of the city, surrounded by the old Jewish and Moorish quarters. When the Christians reconquered the city they were so overwhelmed by its beauty that they built the Cathedral within the Mosque.
- Then we drive past the Sierra Nevada Mountain to the grandeur of hilltop Granada, Spain's most beautiful Moorish-influenced city.

DAY 09 : GRANADA (352KM) / ALICANTE (BREAKFAST / CHINESE LUNCH / WESTERN DINNER)

- Visit the **Alhambra Palace** where occupying a hilly terrace on the south-eastern border of the city of Granada. It was the residence of the Muslim kings of Granada and their court, but is currently a museum exhibiting exquisite Islamic architecture.
- Continue drive to Alicante along the coastal of Mediterranean Sea.

DAY 10 : ALICANTE (181KM) / VALENCIA (358KM) / BARCELONA (BREAKFAST / SEAFOOD PAELLA LUNCH / CHINESE DINNER)

- Today, travel to Valencia , cross the Mora Pass, enjoying superb views over the Sierra Nevada. Pass through palm forests & lemon groves . On arrival , orientation tour to see the **Generalidad Palace**, **El Miguelete Cathedral**, **gates of Serranos**, **Cuarte** and the **modern Centre for Arts & Sciences**
- Continue drive along the Costa Dorada to Barcelona.

DAY 11 BARCELONA/DOHA/KUALA LUMPUR(BREAKFAST)

After breakfast , time to bid farewell to Barcelona and bringing home with sweet memories .

DAY 12 ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR.
