DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your overnight flight to Shenyang via Beijing.

DAY 02 ARRIVAL BEIJING ~ SHENYANG (Lunch / Dinner)

Arrival Beijing in the early morning, take a domestic flight to Shenyang, the capital of Liaoning province. Upon arrival, visit to **Beiling Park**. This park contains many historic buildings, pine trees and lakes. In 1927, Government of the Fengtian Province (later renamed Liaoning Province) established the park. Continue journey to visit the busiest area in Shenyang city, **Taiyuan Street**.

DAY 03 SHENYANG (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, visit to **Shenyang Imperial Palace**. It is the only existing royal palace in China outside of the Forbidden City in Beijing. Early construction began in 1625 by Nurhaci, the founding emperors of the Qing Dynasty. By 1631, additional structures were added under Emperor Huang Taiji. Continue visit to the **ManQing Street**, where the building in the whole street is Qing Dynasty design. Then, transfer to visit **12 Qing Emperors Bronze Statue Square**. Continue visit to **Feather Painting Shop**, then free to shopping at **Zhong Street**.

DAY 04 SHENYANG ~ CHANGCHUN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

In the morning, continue journey to Jilin, the capital of Jilin province. Visit to **Jingyuetan Ski Resort** (exclude skiing fees). The resort boasts one of the longest skiing slopes in Asia and has been famous for its excellent natural skiing conditions. Proceed to visit **Cultural Square**. The square was the main public gathering place for the puppet Manchukuo regime and is the large square in Changchun. Then, visit to **Local Product Shop of Northeast China**.

DAY 05 CHANGCHUN ~ JILIN ~ CHANGCHUN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to Jilin City. Jilin is the only major city with a homologous name to the province which it is located. You will get a chance to view the magnificent **Rimy Pines** along the banks of the Songhua River. It is one of the four natural wonders of China, along with the Guilin Mountains and Streams, Yunnan Stone Forest, and Three Gorges on the Yangtze River (depend on weather to see the rimy pines). Then, transfer to **Beishan Park** (Northern Hill Park). The Park is reminiscent of many of the similar areas in Suzhou and Hangzhou, with pavilions, bridges, corridors and terraces well designed and scattered about among the hills. Transfer back to Changchun.

DAY 06 CHANGCHUN ~ HARBIN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, visit to **Puppet Emperor's Palace**. The Palace was the official residence created by the Imperial Japanese Army for China's last emperor Puyi to live in as part of his role as Emperor of the Japanese puppet state of Manchukuo. After lunch continue journey to the capital of Heilongjiang province, Harbin. After arrival, visit the most prosperous street in Harbin, **Central Street**. It is also an architecture art gallery with the buildings in much kind of the styles such as renaissance, baroque, eclectic, and modern. Then, visit to **Stalin Park**. The park stands as evidence of the friendship between the world's two most powerful communist countries at that time. At the centre of Stalin Park stands the **Flood Control Monument** built to commemorate the tremendous feat of the Harbin people in controlling the massive flood of 1957. The 13m tall monument consists of one Roman style column topped with statues and a long curving corridor surrounding the column.

DAY 07 HARBIN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

In the morning, visit to **St. Sophia Church Square**. This church is the largest Eastern Orthodox Church in the Far East. St. Sophia Church is the perfect example of Byzantine architecture. The main structure is laid out like a cross with the main hall topped with a huge green tipped roof. Go to watch the **Ice Activities** organize by local people. After visit to **Russia Product Shop**, continue journey to **Sun Island** (exclude buggy). The **snow sculpture** at the Sun Island and Ice & Snow World is the main attraction for the Harbin Ice Festival in each year. **Ice & Snow World** first organized by the Harbin government in 1999. The ice carvings at the Ice & Snow World are regarded as some of the world's finest examples of ice art, with visitors able to admire some of the largest and most majestic ice-sculpted masterpieces.

**** Remarks : If Ice & Snow World not open, will be replace by Indoor Ice Lantern; Sun Island Snow Sculpture will be replace by Sun Island Park; Ice Activities will replace by Confucian Temple.**

DAY 08 HARBIN ~ BEIJING ~ KUALA LUMPUR (Breakfast)

In the morning, take a flight back to Kuala Lumpur via Beijing.
