# 7D TAIPEI / SHIHFEN – SKY LANTERN / CHIUFEN / ALISHAN / KAOHSIUNG TEN TRUM / TAINAN CAPITAL CITY / SUN MOON LAKE / TAICHUNG

## DAY 01: ARRIVAL TAIWAN - TAOYUAN

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel, follow by free day.

## DAY 02: TAIPEI / SHIHFEN – RELEASE SKY LANTERN / CHIUFEN / HIGHWAY / MIAOLI / HAKKA MUSEUM / CHIAYI (B / D)

**Shihfen Old Street:** The old street here is connected with the train tracks. The unique railway style of "before the train door" makes many singers MV and the movie "Love Wind" directed by Hou Hsiao-hsien in the past. Shooting, even if you visit a very old street today, you can feel its rich and diverse face.

**Chiufen:** In the early days, it was prosperous because of the abundance of gold mines. After the 1990s, due to the film "Sad City" in Jiufen, Jiufen's unique old-style architecture, sloping land and style attracted the attention of both domestic and foreign, and it also brought life to the region.

**Hakka Museum:** The park covers an area of 11.2 hectares. The park is designed according to the hilly and undulating terrain where the base is located, and the main building is covered with artificial hills composed of water and green landscape roads to create the image of the terraced landscape. It is a global Hakka culture and industry research and exchange center, with functions such as collection, display, sightseeing, and education promotion.

## DAY 03: CHIAYI / ALISHAN NATIONAL FOREST RECREATION AREA – SISTERS LAKES / KAOHSIUNG / FO GUANG SHAN BUDDHA MEMORIAL CENTER (If on TUE will change to Fo Guang Shan) / NIGHT MARKE (B / L)

**Alishan National Forest Recreation Area:** Surrounded by high mountains and surrounded by mountains, the climate is cool. It is famous for its sunrise, sea of clouds, sunset glow, forests and mountain forest railways. The cultural resources of the Tszba aborigines have increased their sightseeing charm. Natural landscapes such as Tashan and sister lakes and alpine lakes are also worth a visit.

**Fo Guang Shan:** It was the Mahayana Buddhism Order. It was founded on May 16, 1967 by Master Kazuo Shizuo, and has become one of the four major Buddhist mountains in Taiwan.

## DAY 04: KAOHSIUNG / THE PIER-2 ART CENTER / QIATOU SUGAR FACTORY / TEN TRUM CIATOU CREATIVE PARK / TAINAN / ANPING OLD STREET / ANPING TREE HOUSE - TAIT / CHINKAN TOWER (B / L / D)

**The Pier-2 Art Center :** Kaohsiung's new attraction, originally the warehouse in Kaohsiung Port, has turned into an artistic base full of art. The art of installation made of iron, injecting new life into the cold warehouse, interesting art shops and small shops full of special features, is also a popular attraction for tourists to visit.

**Qiaotou Sugar Factory:** With more than 100 years of history, it has been listed as a city's cultural landscape. The old antiquities such as sugar factory, Japanese wooden house, air-raid shelter and red brick water tower are well preserved. The social housing offices and clubs that have been inherited from the Japanese era are not only historically significant. In addition to the elevated foundation, the cloister and continuous arches resemble European architectural styles.

**Ten Drums:** The first international art village in Asia for drum music. The creation of the theme Wenchuang Park for drum music art not only allowed the industrial heritage and the development of Taiwan drum music, but also made an important base, and turned the waste sugar factory into a field of cultural and creative sports, creating a miracle in the history of Taiwan's sugar industry and drum music. .

**Anping Old Street:** Yanping Street, also located next to Anping Fort, is also known as "Anping Old Street". It is the first road built by the Dutch in Anping more than 300 years ago. It is also known as the "Taiwan First Street". It is a very worthwhile sight. Legend has it that lovers who have worked together through these two bridges will be able to grow old and love the river forever.

**Chihkan Tower:** Formerly built in 1653, the European-style building was built in 1653. The red-roofed building, known as the Fanzi Building in the land, was once the center of the island, and it has been dumped in the Qing Dynasty, leaving only some remnants.

**DAY 05 TAINAN / HIGHWAY / NANTOU / ABORIGINAL PRODUCT SHOP / SUN MOON LAKE – TAKING A BOAT / WENWU TEMPLE / TAIWANESE TEA CENTER / TAICHUNG / NIGHT MARKET ( B / L )**

**Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area:** Located in Riyue Village, Yuchi Township, Nantou County, Taiwan, the whole pool covers an area of 827 hectares and is about 33 kilometers around the lake. The northern half is shaped like a sun wheel, and the southern half is shaped like a moon hook. Sun Moon Lake has a beautiful scenery, and "Shuangtan Qiuyue" is one of the eight scenic spots in Taiwan.

**Wenwu Temple:** Located on the mountainside of Sun Moon Lake, it was named after Confucius, Yue Fei and Guan Yu. The temple is dominated by golden yellow, towering and imposing, and it is worthy of careful appreciation and taste.



**DAY 06 TAICHUNG / HIGHWAY / TAIPEI / VIGOR KOBO / MARTYRS SHRINE / HANDICRAFT CENTER / TAIPEI 101 SHOPPING DISTRICT / XIMEN ( B / L )**

**Martyr's Shrine:** The revolutionary martyrs from the founding of the Republic of China to the 330,000 soldiers and soldiers who died in the War of Resistance Against Japanese Aggression and the Kuomintang War, on the four walls of the main hall, show the photos and stories of heroic martyrs. In the spring and autumn, the head of state led the Wenwu Baiguan to pay tribute to the flowers. And can watch the handover ceremony of the guards.

**101 Shopping District :** Developed in the 1980s, it has become Taipei's premier central business district. Major facilities such as Taipei 101, Taipei City Government, Taipei City Council, and Taipei World Trade Center are located in the district. Shopping malls, hotels, luxury homes and corporate headquarters.

**Ximending :** It is a favorite of young people nowadays, including movies, fashion, boutiques, exotic goods, tattoos, gourmet snacks, holiday street performers and idol singers to hold signing sessions... etc., all of which make Ximending become The most popular new paradise.
