DAY04: AMSTERDAM/BRUSSEL/PARIS

- Orientation tour includes the World famous bronze sculpture, the Manneken Pis. The Grand Palace, (UNESCO World Heritage Site) and the Market square

- Atomium-Originally constructed for 1958 World Expo

DAY05: PARIS

DAY07: LORRAINE REGION/ BERN

(Buffet Breakfast/Lunch)

- Bern- the capital of Switzerland (UNESCO Heritage Site) Medieval old town, View the 800 year old Clock Tower, Renaissance-style Parliament building
- Bear Park - Home to the bears since 1513



DAY08: BERN/LUCERN

(Buffet Breakfast/Dinner)

- Lucern - Chapel Bridge, Old Town and the Lion Monument. Some free time to visit Bucherer, Europe's Number 1 Shop for watches and jewellery
- Overnight in Central Switzerland Region

DAY09: LUCERN/MILAN

- Lake Como-a popular retreat for wealthy people and Hollywood stars
- Milan - Castello Sforzesco, which was originally a military fortress with defences improved by Leonardo da Vinci, now a museum

- Walk through Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II to arrive in Da Vinci Square.
- Pass by the statue of Leonardo Da Vinci and view the world famous La Scala Opera House
