## DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your overnight flight to Qingdao via Shanghai.

## DAY 02 ARRIVAL SHANGHAI ~ QINGDAO (Dinner)

Arrival Shanghai in the early morning, take a domestic flight to Qingdao. Upon arrival, visit to **Wusi Square**, a large public square in Qingdao's central business district. Named after the nationwide protest May Fourth Movement that started in Qingdao, the square is best recognized by the large "May Wind" (Wuyue Feng) sculpture near the seaside. After that, drive pass **Donghai Road** by coach, this street is decorated by a lot of beautiful sculpture near by the seaside.

## DAY 03 QINGDAO (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, visit to **Xiaoyushan Hill**, one of the best scenic spot along the seaside of Qingdao. From the top of the hill you can see beautiful landscape featuring red tile, green tree and azure sky and blue ocean. Then, transfer to visit **ZhanQiao Pier**. This 440 meter strip that stretches into the sea was the first wharf in Qingdao. This pier is viewed in the eyes of many as the official symbol of Qingdao. Proceed to **Eight Great Passes** (Badaguan). It is made up of eight streets named after the eight great military forts of the ancient times. Along the streets are many classic European houses built when Qingdao was a German protectorate. Continue journey to visit **Tsingtao Beer Museum**, the first professional beer museum in China, a multi-media tourist attraction comprising beer tasting, brewing archive and state of the art display area. Visit to **Mt. Laoshan**. It is the highest coastal mountain in China and known as the birthplace of Taoism. Visit to **Beijiushui Scenic Area**. The name Beijiushui derives its meaning from the mountain that has nine crooks, thus making the river turn nine times. The river starts from the north side of the Ju Peak (the highest peak of Mt. Laoshan) and flows into the valley. So many beautiful things are on this line that it is called 'the Jiushui Gallery'. Continue visit to **Local Product Shop**.

## DAY 04 QINGDAO ~ PENGLAI ~ YANTAI (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Transfer to Penglai after breakfast. Visit to **Penglai Pavilion** upon arrival. Penglai Pavilion is one of the Four Great Towers in China, known as the landing place of the Eight Immortals (Ba Xian) and famous for its occasional mirages. Visit to **Water City** and **Ancient Boat Hall**. Visit to **Bamboo Charcoal Product Shop**. Continue journey to Yantai. Visit to **Yantai Mountain**. Yantai Mountain concentrates over 600 years' history and is the cradle and symbol of the city.

## DAY 05 YANTAI ~ WEIFANG ~ JINAN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Transfer to the "City of Kite", Weifang after breakfast. Upon arrival, visit to **YangJiaBu Folk Arts Daquanyuan**. Inside this village, you will know how to process a kite and traditional New Year Woodcut Picture (Nian Hua). Continue journey to the capital of Shandong Province - Jinan. Jinan is known as the "City of Springs" because of the large number of natural artesian springs. Upon arrival, visit to **Baotu Spring** (Spouting Spring), is a culturally significant artesian karst spring. Baotu means "jumping and leaping" in Chinese. It was declared as the "Number One Spring under the Heaven" by the Qing Dynasty Emperor Qian Long. Visit to **Quancheng Square**. It was built by the municipal government beside the city moat in the early 21st century; at the center is the statue "Spring" which has become a symbol of Jinan.

## DAY 06 JINAN ~ QUFU ~ TAI'AN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

In the morning, transfer to Qufu, the legendary birthplace of Confucius; it served as the capital of the State of Lu during the Spring and Autumn Period. Visit to **Confucius Temple**. Confucius was a famous Chinese thinker and social philosopher. Confucius temple is a temple devoted to the memory of Confucius and the sages and philosophers of Confucianism. This temple is a group of grand buildings built in oriental style and one of the three largest ancient architectural complexes in China. The descendants of Confucius lived in the **Kong Family Mansion**. They were in charge of conducting elaborate religious ceremonies on occasions such as plantings, harvests, honoring the dead, and birthdays. The Kong family was in control of the largest private rural estate in China. Then, visit to **Confucius Cemetery**, served as the family graveyard of Confucius and his descendants for more than 2,300 years. These three sites have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 1994. Continue journey to Tai'an.

## DAY 07 TAI'AN ~ JINAN (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, visit to **Mt. Taishan**, which located at the north of Tai'an city. Taishan is often regarded the foremost of the "Five Sacred Mountains" and is a mountain of historical and cultural significance. The tallest peak is **Jade Emperor Peak** with 1547m. Taishan has been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1987. Continue visit to **Pearl Gallery** and **Baoshutang**. Transfer back to Jinan. Upon arrival, **take a boat ride in Daming Lake**, is the largest lake and one of the "Three Greatest Attractions" in the city of Jinan.

## DAY 08 JINAN ~ SHANGHAI ~ KUALA LUMPUR (Breakfast)

Transfer to airport for your flight back home via Shanghai.
