7D TAIPEI / SHIHFEN – SKY LANTERN / HAOKE SANSHING FARM EXPERIENCE – ABORIGINAL CULTURE / SUN MOON LAKE / CINGJING FARM

DAY 01: ARRIVAL TAIWAN - TAOYUAN

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel, follow by free day.

DAY 02 : TAIPEI / NATIONAL CKS MEMORIAL HALL / SHIHFEN – RELEASE SKY LANTERN / YILAN / JIMMY PARK / DIUDIUDANG FOREST / LUODONG FORESTRY CULTURE GARDEN (B / L / D)

National CKS Memorial Hall : This memorial hall was built in memory of Chiang Kai-shek, the first president of the Republic of China. The memorial hall is white with a blue roof, representing the dominant colors in the ROC flag. A bronze statue of Chiang looks west symbolically to the Presidential Office Building and mainland China.

Shihfen Old Street: The old street here is connected with the train tracks. The unique railway style of "before the train door" makes many singers MV and the movie "Love Wind" directed by Hou Hsiao-hsien in the past. Shooting, even if you visit a very old street today, you can feel its rich and diverse face.

Jimmy Park: It is a magnified version of Taiwan's well-known illustrator Jimmy's picture book. The square has a statue body that turns left and right to the male and female protagonists. There are also many color drawing walls and various luggage, handbags and other interesting landscaping, which makes people feel like walking into the color. Colorful imagination of the world.

Diudiudang Forest: The image of a combination of train folk songs and green woods is a beautiful work by the architect Huang Shengyuan.

Luodong Forestry Culture Garden: Taiwan's three major forest farms, Taiping Mountain, Alishan and Baxian Mountain, of which Taiping Mountain has the largest output. In the initial stage, manpower logging, skidding, and transportation materials were transported to Yilan Mountain by Lanyang Stream. Due to the construction of the Qingshui Lake hydropower plant, it was impossible to manage the flow of materials. In 1924, the forest railway was completed, and the mountainous area was changed to steam collectors, tracks and ropeway materials.

DAY 03 : YILAN / FRIENDLY GARDEN – FARM EXPERIENCE – ABORIGINAL CULTURE / HSUESHAN TUNNEL / HANDICRAFT CENTER / MIAOLI / HAKKA MUSEUM / TAICHUNG / KAOMEI WETLAND (B / L / D)

Friendly Garden: Professionals will receive a variety of organic farming cultures in the four seasons of spring, summer, autumn and winter, experience farmer farming in the countryside, cultivation in greenhouses, etc., taste the rural meals and aboriginal diets of non-toxic farming and experience the native people of Yilan. Life culture and art creation.

Hakka Museum: The park covers an area of 11.2 hectares. The park is designed according to the hilly and undulating terrain where the base is located, and the main building is covered with artificial hills composed of water and green landscape roads to create the image of the terraced landscape. It is a global Hakka culture and industry research and exchange center, with functions such as collection, display, sightseeing, and education promotion.

Kaomei Wetland: Kaomei Wildlife Sanctuary is an ecological protection area on the west coast of Taiwan. It is located on the west side of Qingshui District of Taichung City, including the Dajiaxi Estuary. It is a combination of freshwater water injection and tidal alternating wetlands.

DAY 04 : TAICHUNG / 921 EARTHQUAKE MUSEUM / NANTOU / ABORIGINAL PRODUCT SHOP / SUN MOON LAKE – TAKING A BOAT / WENWU TEMPLE / GUANGXING PAPER CRAFTS – DIY / PULI TOWN / TAI YI ECOLOGICAL LEISURE FARM – DIY (B / L / D)

921 Earthquake Education Park: To preserve the original site of the earthquake, record the history of the earthquake, and provide living materials for the public and the school about earthquake education.

Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area: Located in Riyue Village, Yuchi Township, Nantou County, Taiwan, the whole pool covers an area of 827 hectares and is about 33 kilometers around the lake. The northern half is shaped like a sun wheel, and the southern half is shaped like a moon hook. Sun Moon Lake has a beautiful scenery, and "Shuangtan Qiuyue" is one of the eight scenic spots in Taiwan.

Wenwu Temple: Located on the mountainside of Sun Moon Lake, it was named after Confucius, Yue Fei and Guan Yu. The temple is dominated by golden yellow, towering and imposing, and it is worthy of careful appreciation and taste.

Guangxing Paper Crafts: Guangxing Paper Craft is a paper mill in Taiwan that combines cultural preservation and tourism development.

**DAY 05 : NANTOU / CINGJING-GREEN GREEN GRASSLANDS - SKYWALK / TAIWANESE TEA CENTER /
CHUNG TAI CHAN MONASTERY / TAICHUNG / NIGHT MARKET (B / L)**

Cingqing Grassland: The Qingqing Grassland at an altitude of 1800 meters is the most beautiful piece of pure land in Cingjing Farm. The Cingqing grassland was formerly a virgin forest, and later built into a livestock area, it became the current green grassland.

Chung Tai Chan Monastery: It looks like the Aladdin Temple is in Nantou Puli, Taiwan! This beautiful building - the main building of the Zhongtai Zen Temple is 136 meters high (37-story stilts)!

DAY 06 TAICHUNG / HIGHWAY / TAIPEI / VIGOR KOBO / MARTYRS SHRINE / TAIPEI 101 SHOPPING DISTRICT / XIMEN (B / L)

Martyr's Shrine: The revolutionary martyrs from the founding of the Republic of China to the 330,000 soldiers and soldiers who died in the War of Resistance Against Japanese Aggression and the Kuomintang War, on the four walls of the main hall, show the photos and stories of heroic martyrs. In the spring and autumn, the head of state led the Wenwu Baiguan to pay tribute to the flowers. And can watch the handover ceremony of the guards.

101 Shopping District : Developed in the 1980s, it has become Taipei's premier central business district. Major facilities such as Taipei 101, Taipei City Government, Taipei City Council, and Taipei World Trade Center are located in the district. Shopping malls, hotels, luxury homes and corporate headquarters.
